## *Special Congregational Meeting*

On August 29th, 2010, at 2:00 pm, in the Fellowship Hall the second vote on whether to remain with the ELCA or move to the TAALC will be taken. Our constitution requires there to be a second vote for this final decision. There will need to be a 2/3 majority vote of voting members attending. The Motion and Voting Member Guidelines follow,

### **Motion**

It is moved that Prince of Peace Lutheran Church of Evansdale, Iowa, Blackhawk County, Iowa withdraw our membership from the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA) and become a member congregation of the American Association of Lutheran Churches (TAALC).

### **Voting Members**

#### Article IV— Membership

- 1a. It is therefore required of all members that they:
- 1) Make diligent use of the Means of Grace on a regular basis
  - 2) Live their lives according to God’s Will as revealed in the Scriptures and clarified in the teachings of the Lutheran Church.
  - 3) Support the work of the congregation and the Lutheran Church on a regular basis
  - 4) Attend at least 12 worship services during the year unless sickness or age prohibits their attendance
- 4a. Voting membership shall be those baptized and confirmed members of this congregation who have attained the age of eighteen and have been duly accorded this status by the congregation in accordance with its BY-LAWS.
